



Dress Code - Townsville Golf Club

The Townsville Golf Club requires a respectable standard of dress consistent with a rural private club. Members are responsible for ensuring their guests adhere to our club dress code. The Townsville Golf Club reserves the right to refuse admission to any person, who in the opinion of an employee or agent of the club, is deemed to be inappropriately attired. Thank you in advance for you co-operation.

Golf Course and Practice Facilities

Whether playing or practicing, all members and visitors of the Club must be attired in clothing designed for golf. (NOT casual wear adapted for golf)

- Male & female players must wear a collared shirt or specified golf shirt at all times.
- Predominately white socks.
- Covered footwear.

EXCLUDED: Members and visitors of the Club may NOT at any time wear:

- Metal spiked golf shoes.
- Cargo shorts / trousers, jeans, tracksuits, or other casual wear not designed for golf.
- Motifs larger than pocket size.
- Gym attire (Exception Swingfit Classes) and sports singlets.

Club House

We recognise members and visitors of the Club wish to enjoy our hospitality facilities in a more relaxed manner and therefore patrons are requested to dress accordingly. We ask that members and their guests dress in **neat casual attire**.

EXCLUDED: Members and visitors of the Club may NOT at any time wear:

- Ripped, frayed or torn jeans (including designer).
- Gym Attire
